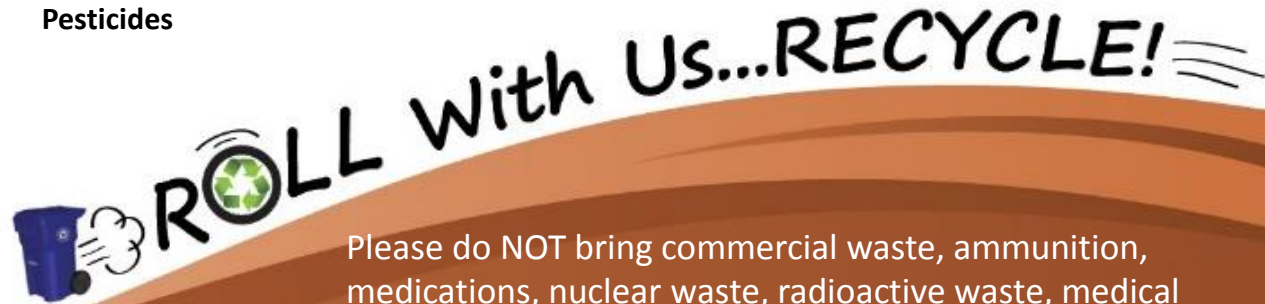
# What Household Hazardous Waste Can I Bring to the Recycling Event?

Leftover Household Products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable, or reactive ingredients are considered to be "Household Hazardous Waste." It is important to dispose of HHW properly to keep our landfill, and our community, safe. As a guide, here is a list of items that are accepted at our Residential Recycling Event, and year-round at any of the 5 Customer Convenience Centers. Aerosol spray cans-partially full  
Air-conditioning Freon  
Ammonia  
Antifreeze  
Batteries-lithium, nickel, lead acid  
Bathroom/kitchen cleaners  
Bleach  
Brake fluid  
Disinfectants  
Drain cleaners  
Fertilizer  
Fire extinguishers  
Flea collars, repellent, powder  
Floor and furniture polish/cleaner  
Fluorescent lightbulbs

Please do NOT bring commercial waste, ammunition, medications, nuclear waste, radioactive waste, medical waste or explosives (fireworks, flares, etc). Please note that single-use alkaline batteries are safe to dispose in the trash.
